



## Urban Mitts Pattern

### Materials Needed:

Size US4 DPNS  
1 skeins Bernat Premium  
Worsted  
1 stitch markers  
2 Buttons  
Thread for sewing buttons  
Needle for weaving in ends

### Abbreviations:

CO – cast on  
K – Knit  
k2tog – knit 2 together  
Kfb – Knit front & back  
sts – stitches  
BO – bind off  
slm - slip marker  
optional: duplicate stitch



### Urban Mitts Pattern Instructions:

CO 44 sts on US4 DPNS join and place marker to work in the round.

K2, P2 until piece measures 4" or desired length of cuff.

Begin Hand:

Round 1- K2tog, Knit all until 22 sts remain, K2tog, knit until end of round. (42 sts on needles)

Round 2-4 - Knit all sts

Thumb Increase:

Round 5 - Kfb, K1, Kfb, k to end of round (44 sts on needles)

Round 6 & 7 - Knit all sts

Round 8 - Kfb, K3, Kfb, Knit to end of round (46 sts on needles)

Round 9 & 10 – Knit all sts

Round 11 - Kfb, K5, Kfb, Knit to end of round (48 sts on needles)

Round 12 & 13 - Knit all sts

Round 14 – Kfb, K7, Kfb, Knit to end of round (50 sts on needles)

Round 15 & 16 – Knit all sts

Round 17 – Kfb, K9, Kfb, Knit to end of round (52 sts on needles)

Round 18 & 19 – Knit all sts

Round 20 – Kfb, K11, Kfb, Knit to end of round (54 sts on needles)

Round 21 & 22 – Knit all sts

Round 23 – Slip 15 sts (thumb sts) onto scrap yarn.

**Continue Hand:**

CO 3 sts & join (without thumb sts) Place marker to work in the round – (42 sts on needles)  
Knit all rounds until piece measures aprox 5” allowing for additional ¼” fingerless cuff.

Fingerless Cuff:

K1, P1 Rib for ¼” and BO in rib pattern. Cut yarn.

**Continue Thumb:**

Slip 15 sts onto two US 4 DPNS

With third needle pick up and knit the 3 CO sts of the hand.

Join and Place marker to work in the round.

Knit all rounds until thumb measures 1”

Knit in P1, K1 Rib for 2 rounds and BO in rib pattern. Cut Yarn

**Thumb Flap:**

Pick up 8 sts just below ribbing & CO 9 sts on second needle so the CO sts lay across/on top of the picked up sts. Place marker and join, knitting in the round until desired length

\*\* k1,p1 rib on the co stitches of the flap for 3 rows, ensuring to only knit the picked up sts)

**(allow ¼” for decreases).**

First decrease \*K1, K2tog\* rep until end of round

K2tog all sts **(ensure flap fits over thumb)**

Cut yarn and thread through remaining sts, pull tight and weave in ends inside.

**Fingers Flap:**

Pick 22 up sts ¼” below ribbing.

CO 22 sts on second needle so the CO sts lay across/on top of the picked up sts. Place marker and join, knitting in the round until desired length

\*\* k1,p1 rib on the co stitches of the flap for 4 rows, ensuring to only knit the picked up sts)

**(allow 2” for decreases).**

Begin Decrease:

Round 1 - \*K2, K2tog\* repeat until end of round

Round 2 – Knit all sts

Round 3 – \*K1, K2tog\* repeat until end of round

Round 4 – Knit all sts

Round 5 – K2tog until end of round **(ensure flap fits over fingers)**

Cut yarn leaving a tail, slip though sts and pull tight. Weave in end inside.

Repeat pattern instructions for second mitten ensuring you flip it over for the opposing hand when attaching the flaps.

**Finishing Options:**

Secure Buttons to top of hand portion of mitten where the finger flaps will lay when pulled back  
Knit 2 l cords long enough to snugly fit around buttons & attach to top of finger flaps.

Any chart design can be used that is 20 sts wide as long as it fits on the mitten / flap depending on the total length of your mitten.

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
